# Reflecting on another year of impact

In 2025, children and families experienced hope in real and lasting ways because of you. Since 1956, our vision has been for every child to have a stable, loving home — and together with you, that vision becomes more real with every life touched.

In 2025, we reached over one million children and families. From meeting critical medical needs for 255,944 children and families to ensuring 26,647 children and young adults could attend school, you restored life-giving hope across communities around the world.

When severe flooding displaced families from their homes, you provided emergency relief so they could rebuild their lives. Through Gifts of Hope — from goats to garden supplies — you empowered parents to rise above poverty and help their children grow and thrive.

Through Food Every Day, Holt’s new community of monthly donors, 2,322,066 meals were served to hungry children and families. And as we continue our work to keep children safely with their birth families, 40,235 children remained or were reunited with their families through ongoing care. You also helped 181 children join permanent, loving families through both international and domestic adoption.

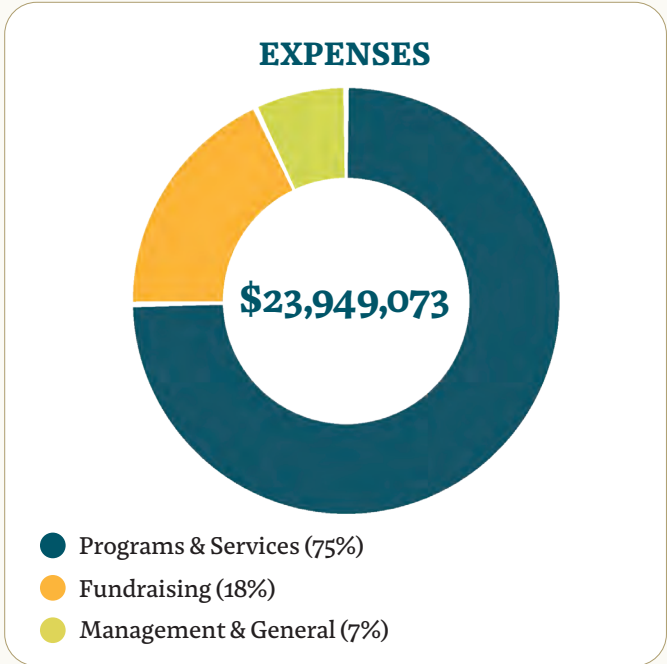
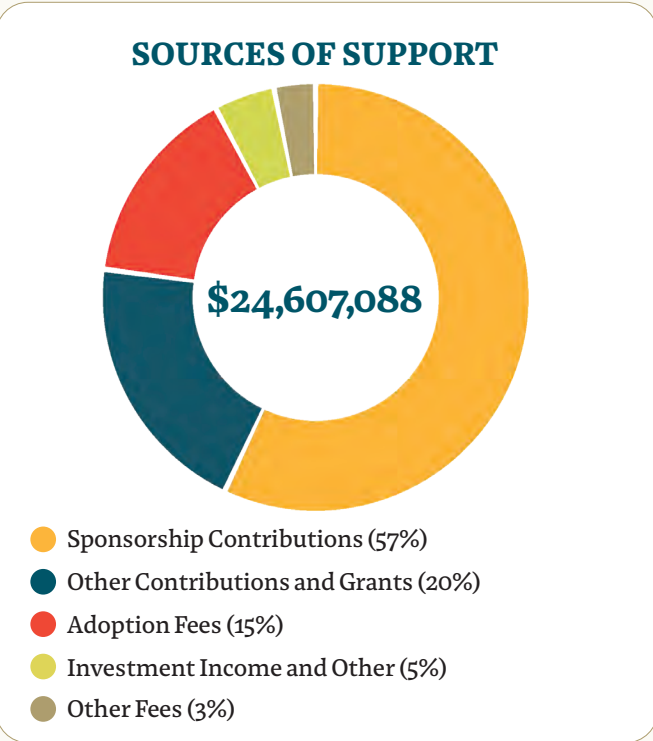

On vision trips to Mongolia and Thailand, participants witnessed firsthand the profound impact of their kindness and generosity on the lives of children and families in need. ## THAILAND VISION TRIP



*"I started to see the [focus of Holt's work]... has been changing and shifting from international adoption to domestic adoption and domestic care for the children. I am very touched by this. ... Now, we start to see the emphasis is so much in the community and trying the very best to keep children in their families instead of growing up in institutions. All these big changes you did seamlessly, very well. That's our experience on the tour — visiting the orphanage, the families and the single parents. ... This Thailand trip was also so beautifully arranged. Not just orderly, but beautifully."*

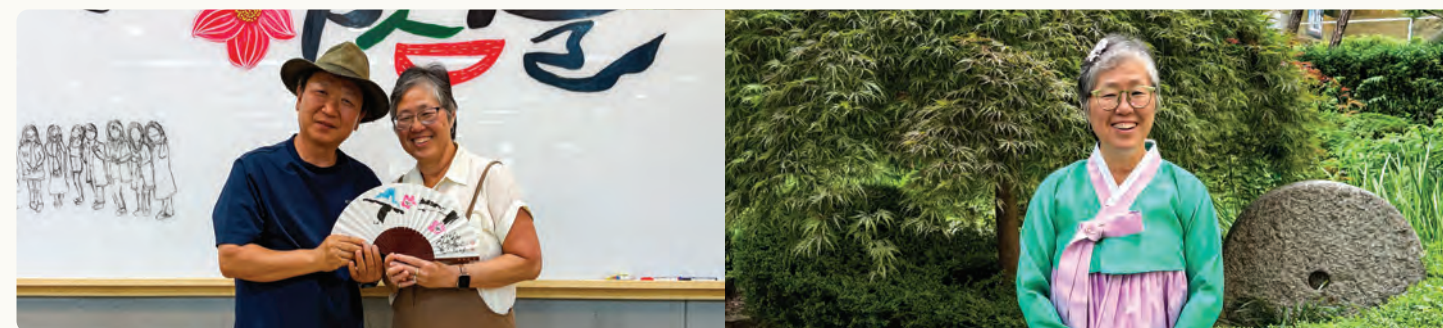
## MONGOLIA VISION TRIP



*"During my recent visit to Mongolia with Holt's vision trip, I had the privilege of meeting with the two young girls that I have been sponsoring for the last two years. It was unseasonably cold last October with temperatures often dipping well below freezing. ... I stayed an extra day to go shopping for winter gear for my girls so they would be well-equipped to face the winter season. ... They opened every package and tried everything on immediately with lots of smiles and giggles! The visit was a great reminder that our support goes beyond material gifts — it reinforces the importance of providing both practical aid and emotional encouragement as they grow into young women and pursue their dreams."*

## KOREA HERITAGE TOUR



*"I did not immediately remember things when I got off the plane in Korea. I did not recognize certain sites. Nothing looked or smelled familiar or like home. What I did find was a sense of belonging. I found some answers to questions that I didn't even know I had. Answers that started to fill that hole in my heart. I found a connection with other adoptees who had similar experiences to mine. And as I talked with the other Korean adoptees on the trip, I found that hole getting smaller and smaller. These fellow adoptees who may have had different journeys, but all found ourselves in Korea at this exact moment."*
